

Intra-EU labour mobility

Annual report (Edition 2024)

Description

The report highlights an increase in working-age EU movers in 2023, who generally have higher activity and employment rates compared to nationals and third-country nationals. However, these movers face greater risks of poverty and social exclusion. The report also emphasises significant mobility among healthcare workers, many of whom are on permanent contracts and are ageing. Additionally, there is positive net mobility, with more people entering the EU than leaving and the majority of incoming EU movers are male and young adults. Overall, the report underscores the importance of intra-EU mobility for the labour market and social conditions within the EU.

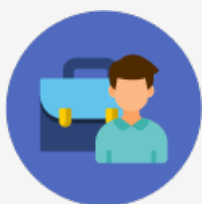
