Eligible group(s)	Micro companies and SMEs (crafts, cooperatives) employing IVET students under 18 years old in shortage occupations (chimney man, automotive sector, installers, waiters, tailors, cook, butcher, baker, carpenter)
Education and training eligible	The instrument finances apprenticeship and other forms of education and training. It applies to EQF 4 level.
Source of financing and collection mechanism	State (national resources), EU funds: 2016: ESF (85% of overall public funding), national resources (15%) 2015: ERDF (85% of overall public funding), national resources (15%)

	50% in case of mentor remuneration The maximum amount a company may receive is HRK 75,000 (approx. EUR 10,000) (the highest possible support for mentor remuneration). Funds are disbursed to all eligible applicants on the basis of the legal entitlement.
Volumes of funding	In 2016, the public funding amounted to approx. EUR 405,000 (HRK 3,000,000). This included approx. EUR 60,750 from national resources (15% of overall public funding) and approx. EUR 344,250 of EU funding (85% of overall public funding). In 2015, the public funding amounted to approx. EUR 432,000 (HRK 3,200,000).
