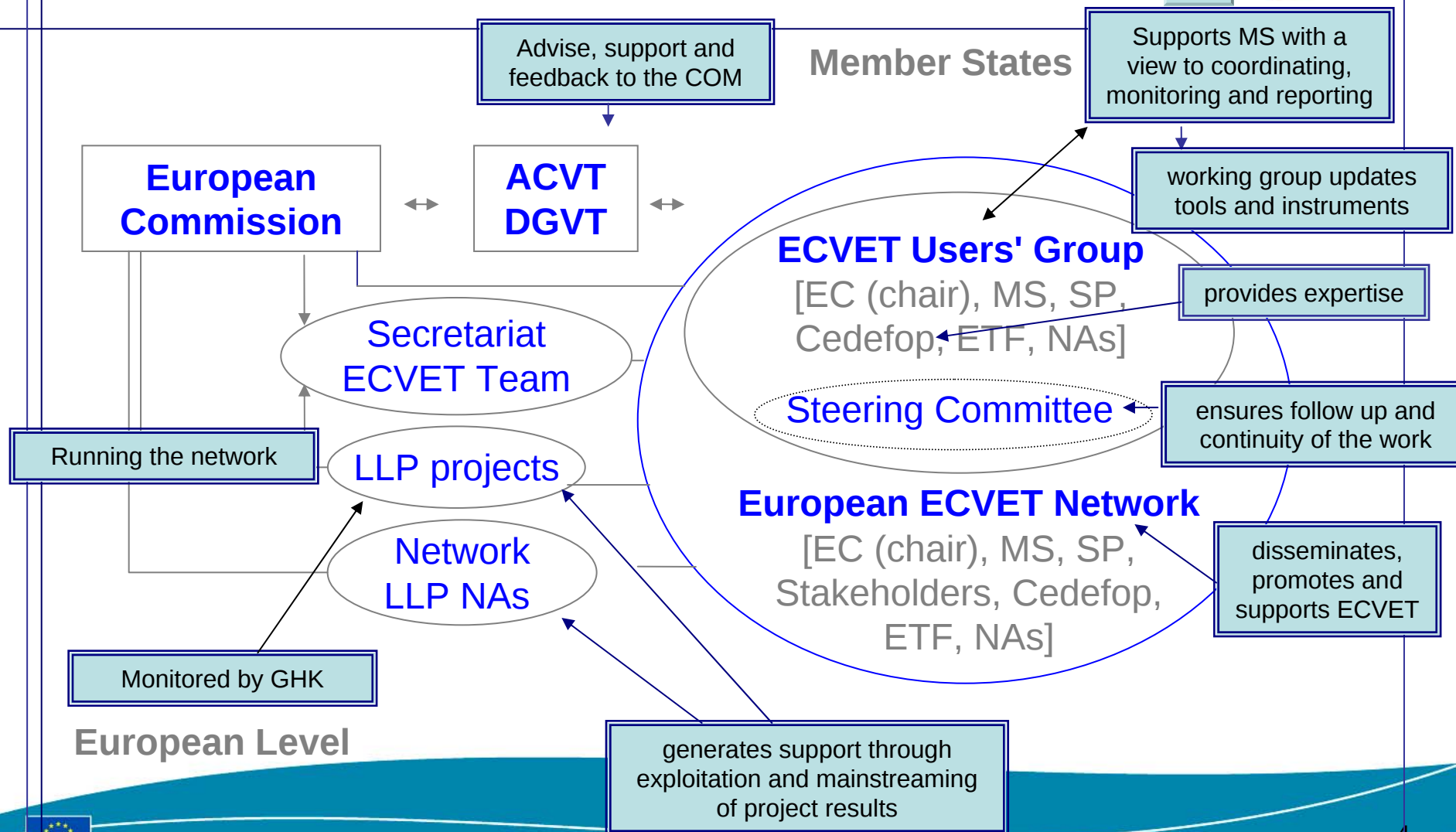


Timeline

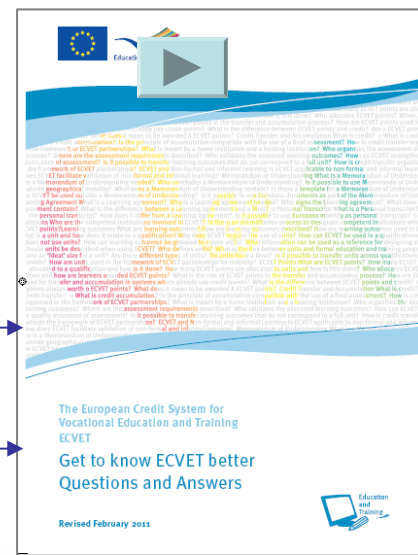
