



**Scenario for a one-year action (from 1st January to 31st December) under
Framework Partnership Agreement GP/DSI/ReferNet-FPA/002/20**

The applicant meeting the selection criteria will be assessed against the award criteria mentioned under Section 3.4 of the Call for proposals (based on the information provided in Section 3 of the grant application form in Annex I).

For this purpose a 'scenario' including deliverables to be submitted and deadlines for submission is presented to the applicant.

1. The applicant is requested to **describe a detailed methodology** to carry out the whole range of activities foreseen in the scenario for the year. All deliverables below shall be covered. The methodology will be assessed against Criteria 1-4 (Section 3.4 of the Call).
2. The applicant shall draft a **news item** in English (see below 1b), which will be evaluated against Criterion 5 under Section 3.4.

Remark: Criterion 1c will be used only to assess the existence and nature of the letter attached to the application form as indicated under Section 3.4 of the Call.

1a) Provide structured information on progress towards the five medium-term deliverables (MTDs) set out in the Riga Conclusions ⁽²⁾ . Information should be based on factual and up-to-date qualitative and quantitative data through desk research and interviews on national policy measures and actions taken in 2020 indicating clearly: • concise background information to understand the 'why' of the policy development; • the main objectives of the policy development; • key stakeholders involved;	End of February

The article should also highlight policy and practice developments of the last five years 2015-20.
